### State Association-Managed Process

#### 1. Funding:

- NACA provides a set amount of funds to the state association for scholarships.

#### 2. Scholarship Management:

- The state association is responsible for managing the announcement, selection, and logistics for the recipients.

#### 3. Reporting:

- 30 days post-conference, the state association organization is required to submit a report to NACA with the names, contact emails, and scholarship details (full, partial, amounts, etc.) given to each recipient using the report template provided on page 3.

#### 4. Accountability:

- The state association agrees to use the funds as outlined and report all use of funds including unused funds. All scholarship funds are required to be spent in 2026.
